Responsibilities:

- Conduct the Yankee Station Regatta in conjunction with other sail racing members within the parameters of fun, sportsmanship and safety.
- Select, train and brief the Race Committee for each race.
- Brief racing crews before races.
- Ensure that races are conducted properly and safely.
- Determine correct handicap ratings for racing yachts.
- Maintain racing records.
- Determine award winners at the completion of each series and season.
- Two or more disinterested members of the Permanent Race Committee, or other sailors appointed by the Permanent Race Committee will adjudicate protests.
- Provide official race results after each race.
- The Rear Commodore for Racing, or Race Captain, or in their absence, another member of the Permanent Race Committee shall approve the race course tentatively selected by the ROD.

On-Water Scoring:

The boat that collects finishing times at the finish line will call either **Mark Wolfe (cell: 206-7903)** or **John Lones (cell: 561-3626)** with finishing times as they occur. Do not wait for the last boat to finish before you call. All racing skippers and crew are invited to the clubhouse immediately after folding sails to get race results and share "sea stories." The clubhouse was equipped with a new computer in 2010, so results may be seen and printed immediately after the race. Race results will normally be posted on the OPCYC web site by midnight the day of the race.
